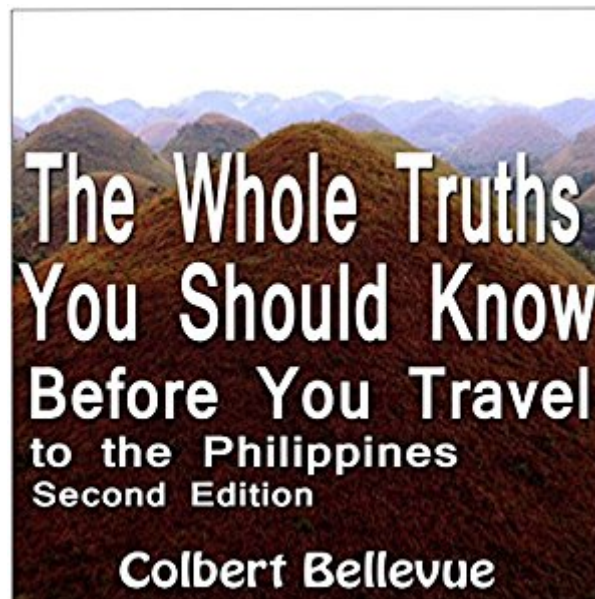




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The Whole Truths You Should Know Before You Travel To The Philippines: Second Edition
