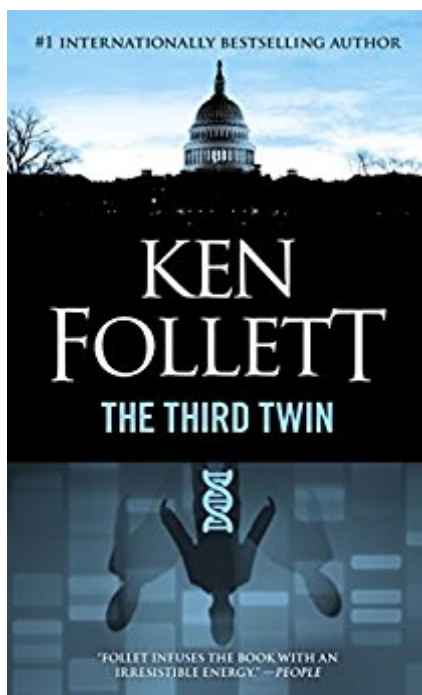

I'm an identical twin (now 78 years old) and enjoyed the book tremendously. It was a bit hard for me to understand how so many people failed to distinguish between many of the cloned 'twins'. This factor did not bother me at all, however, and I recommended to several twins I know. I wonder whether other twins like me who read the book had a similar issue with the story... This is not the usual work of Ken Follett. The story is valid. The characters are valid. You have to be able to come to terms with a research program gone very much awry, and kept hidden for two decades. The consequences of the mistakes made by the scientists naturally surface, and create havoc in parts of society. Due to the work of Dr. Ferrami, the mistakes are uncovered, at a crucial time. She perseveres, and the truth does out. It's a good read. However, it didn't rivet my attention the way other works of Mr. Follett have.,

Mostly I liked this book, but I thought the ending really was rather contrived. I suppose it had to be that way to make it all come out right, but it seemed artificial. Otherwise, I enjoyed it. It kept me in suspense throughout.

Follett's books are always very good - unexpected twists to the story and lots of action. But this was one of my very favorites of his.

Ken Follett is sometimes a very good writer, but when you write so much, some of it has got to be less. This is a lesser work by a very good author.

Not his best. A bit dragging at times. Language a bit old fashioned... most real people use contractions when speaking to friends and lovers.

I like Follet and he knows how to write, but I had a hard time staying interested. Also a bit dated in 2017.

I always enjoy a story by Ken Follett. They are imaginative, clever and well written. The characters are "real". I am always eager to get to the next chapter.
