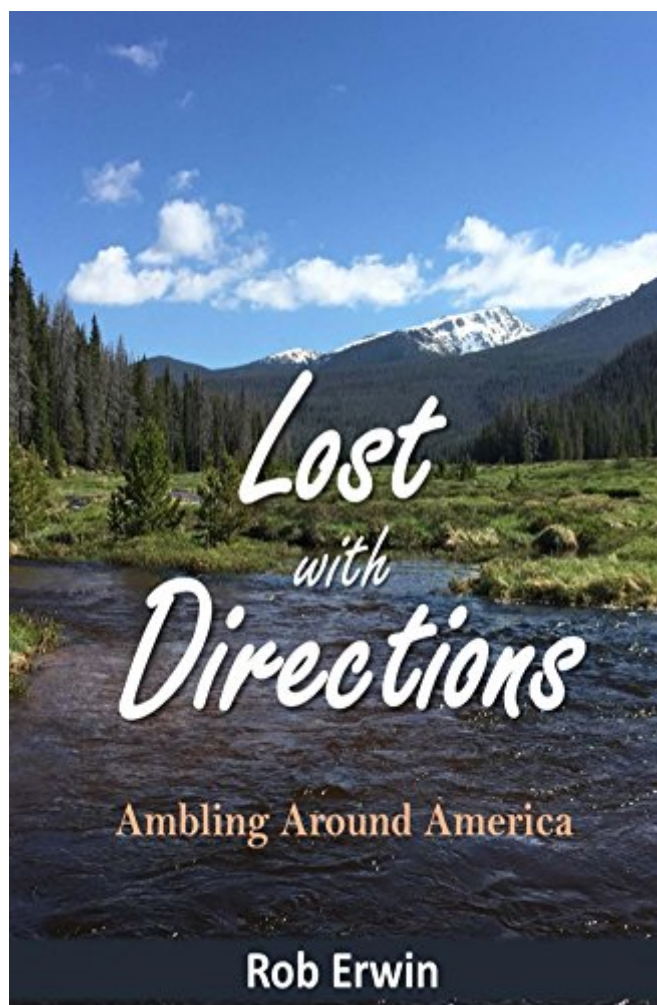

This book is about Mr. Erwin's vacation.
