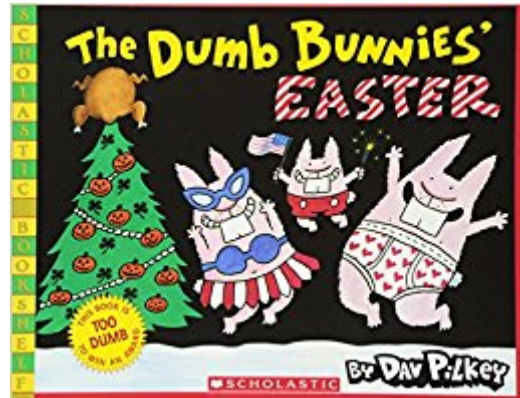

Kindergarten-Grade 2?The Dumb Bunnies get ready on December 24th to celebrate Easter by hanging a Merry Halloween sign with shamrocks on it, buying an Easter tree, spray-painting fried eggs, and waiting for Santa, who arrives in a red minivan pulled by eight flying pilgrims. Such goofiness makes for a fun read, and that's why Harry Allard and James Marshall were so successful with the Stupids (Houghton). There is absolutely nothing new here, however, except that the characters are rabbits. The style of art is much like Marshall's; even the page outlines and type are the same. At first glance, one would swear this is another installment of Space Case (Dial, 1980). For Marshall's many fans, it may be a welcome story; however, be forewarned that it falls short of the inspired silliness of the Stupids.?Christine A. Ages 5-7. The Bunny family is a worthy successor to those all-time favorites the Stupids. Here, the bunnies have some holiday problems. For example, they expect the Easter Bunny to come in a "shiny red minivan pulled by eight flying pilgrims." Their glorious ability to get every single thing wrong will leave preschoolers in stitches. The illustrations--done by an artist who describes his medium as "watercolors, India ink, acrylics, and Hamburger Helper"--match the story perfectly: pink, buck-toothed, and round in the middle, the bunnies are goofy indeed. These may well be the most stupid books you'll ever read to your child - which is exactly why they love them! My granddaughters are 5 and some of the humor escapes them, but they notice or understand enough to put Dumb Bunny books on their must-read list. I did buy this as an Easter gift for them, but of course being Dumb Bunnies, Easter was the opposite of what they were celebrating. A fun read!

My 3.5 year old thinks the dumb bunnies are the greatest thing she's ever read. We read at least two dumb bunnies books every day and the Easter book did not fail. Bonus: it can be a Christmas book too. We also use them to get her to do what she needs to do to get ready. She'll do something silly to waste time and we'll say "you must be a dumb bunny. Should we send you to live with them?" She'll giggle and say no then finish getting ready.

This book was a big hit with my grandson who is 8. He really laughed and read it several times. When my children were his age, we read books about the "Stupids". My kids loved this book! We do a Christmas book advent every year, and try to add a few new books to the mix each year. This one was a huge hit with all my kids, though the husband was a bit confused with what was going on. Cute illustrations and funny, non-traditional story of a family of bunnies getting ready to celebrate Christmas. My kids were rolling on the floor laughing at the silliness of this book.

I hesitated to give this book a 5 star rating, since it hardly is a work of "fine literature." However, what pushed me into the 5 star category was the sheer delight of seeing my 6 year old son laugh out loud as he read the pages. If the goal of this book was to get my son to really get into a book he was reading, then the goal was met. The Dumb Bunnies' Easter is great for the K-2 crowd - because the pictures are funny, the sentences and word selection is manageable for them, and the jokes are not over their heads. In fact -the jokes are right at their level - which is often hard to find in the "Easy Reader" literature. For these reasons, I rate it a 5 star book - It is actually more clever than dumb. But it still is pretty dumb! Also - FYI, if I had to pick one holiday to break out this book, I'd choose Christmas time - since most of the references are more about Christmas than any other holiday. It definitely has a Christmas-y sort of feel despite the Easter title.

My friend's children have been taught readding isn't fun. Pilkey changes that...

This book is very silly. It made my son and I laugh. A lot of the humor is obvious, but some of the humor is more subtle, so I think this book is good for a broader range of ages, such as 4 to 8, depending on the child. A child could read this several times before discovering all the jokes and holiday related anachronisms and absurdities. I got this for my son for Easter, but it would work for any holiday or just because!

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
