A fascinating take on the Judeo/Roman conflict of old. The plot moves quickly and the characters are well-developed. The book invokes a vivid picture of what I imagine ancient Rome to have been like with the armies and how they waged war. The book leaves you wondering in which direction the author plans to go next. My only criticism is the liberal use of the "F" word. In my opinion that limits the audience that will or can read the book and is too much.

Amazing, fast paced, intense, dramatic. This is going to be a memorable series. There are some intense scenes that not all people will like, but fit into the storyline great. Characters are extremely well developed, you'll learn to love them or hate them and sometimes feel both about one.

Small countries being gobbled up by a huge empire with professional soldiers. Courage and cowardice abound in strange places, Honor and back-stabbing also occur. Brutality exists and is common. The magic of luminosity plays a part. Reminds me a lot of the Roman Wars against the Jews, and of course the names add to that.
