

I read quite a few books in preparation for IVF and this was definitely my favorite and was certainly the most helpful. It had so much information and didn't gloss over the details like a lot of other books do. All of the other books that I read seemed to really "dumb down" the entire IVF process, whereas this book didn't. If you want real facts rather than generalizations, this is the book for you. Almost all of my more specific questions were answered in this book and I loved how it included so much research and just really detailed information. There are sections on quite a large variety of topics, and a lot of them may not apply to you. But whatever issue you are dealing with that has led you to IVF, will be discussed in this book. For us specifically, we are dealing with male factor. Every other book I've picked up about IVF has done little more than simply mention that male factor exists, so being able to read some actual information about it was wonderful.

Dr. Sher is quite thorough in this book and I am very happy I bought it BEFORE I venture into IVF. He explains different reasons for infertility and in my case, gave a very good description of the immunological reasons for infertility. I would definitely suggest others buy this book before they go into IVF. It is technical and helpful so you know what your doctor is talking about.
