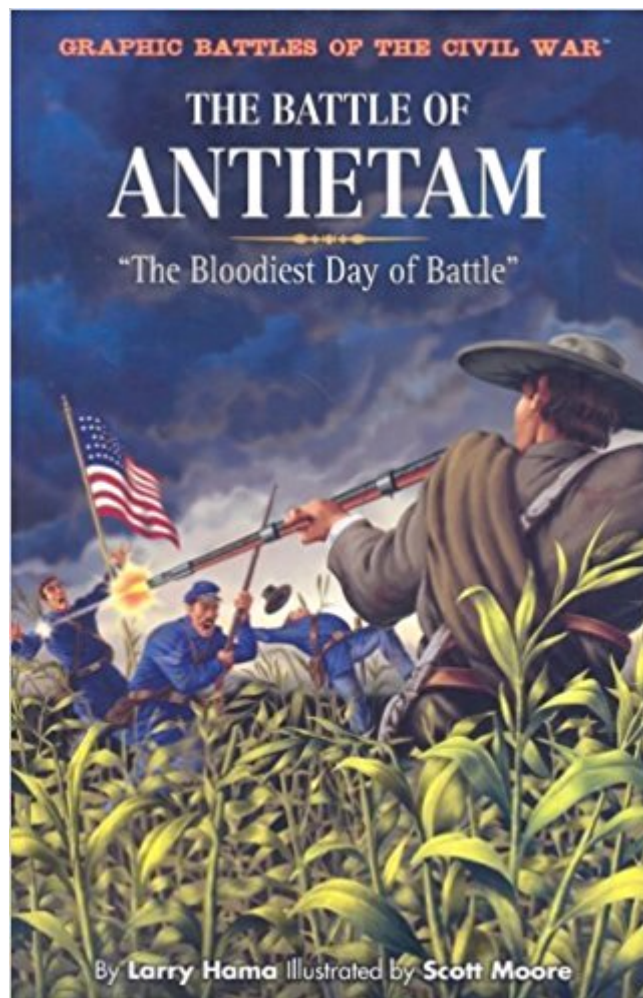




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The Battle Of Antietam: "The Bloodiest Day Of Battle" (Graphic Battles Of The Civil War)
