

This quick read had nice pictures and the story flows easily. I just couldn't stay connected with the story. I'm sure children though of very young ages will enjoy getting it read to them.

Charlie the owl is not like the rest. He can't sit still, he has to dance. Which drives everyone else nuts, so off he must go on a new home hunt. He spies so many still animals, will he always be lost? No, there's a tree with a jubilant lot! Is this where he belongs? Who has children? And boys especially? The smooth rhyming prose and colorful fun pictures got mine's attention and we sat mostly still for the short bit it took to read this. As fantastic as the first, and I especially enjoy how all three stories intertwine with each other to teach love and acceptance.

Pleasant story, great artwork and nice rhyming make this children's book a winner! (Although were I a squirrel with an owl as my neighbor I think I would be watching my backside - haha!) Very good book!

I really like this text for young readers. The images draw you in and the rhyming words transport you into a wonderful adventure of Charlie finding his place in the world (as we all should). Some of the images (even Charlie) remind me of Roald Dahl's James and the Giant Peach. I like this one for young children and readers!

My two toddlers love this story. It is a great bedtime book. It is about Charlie the dancing owl finding a home where he belongs. The illustrations are cute, funny and nicely colored, and I also like the beat of the rhymes. It is fun to read and holds my children's attention well.

I thought this was a pretty cute little book. I didn't think the meter and rhyming was that great, but

the artwork is sweet and my two year old enjoyed it very much. It has a nice little story in there and I don't think any kids will care about the little nit picks that I had.

This is a cute story with colorful pictures and fun sounds. I have it just three stars because I felt the story could have been developed much further to engage the reader by showing character development. As it is, it's just a happening in an owl's life. It could become much more.
