What a waste of time and money. This book could've been printed on one sheet of paper, but it somehow filled out "34 pages" by using excessive margins and double spacing. Seriously - 16 recipes in this "book" and half are slight variations of another one. Huge disappointment. I could've found all of these recipes online. I feel like this was a project done for a middle school home economics class.

The few recipes are in it are quite ordinary, but good; however, it is not what I expected and I am disappointed. I thought I was getting a "cookbook", instead I got a booklet with 16 recipes in it. Certainly not worth what I paid for it. Ms. Thomas-Smith should be a little more honest in the advertising and lower the price if this is all she has to offer.

16 very basic recipes. The other 16 pages are just metric conversions and disclaimers from the author (I use this term lightly). Nothing dynamic about this at all. Don't bother.

Instead of a cookbook, this is more like a pamphlet on how to cook sweets. There are three recipes on how to cook traditional meals, the rest is not worth reading. There are other British cook books on that have many recipes, and are 7 times cheaper than this one. This did not even mention Cornish Pasties, Yorkshire Pudding, or Lancashire Hot Pot, but it did have fish and chips. Wow.

Highly overpriced tiny book. Not what was expected or what I thought was implied. I would have dealt with it but recipes gave little instruction aside from the ingredients. I wish I read more reviews since others have said the same. This book should be priced for 99 cents.

Anyone interested in British recipes will surely want to grab a copy of this book! Each recipe is easy to follow; however, if something is confusing a nifty conversion chart is found at the end of the book! So if you are looking for a Christmas cake or an Irish stew, this book is for you! Happy cooking!
