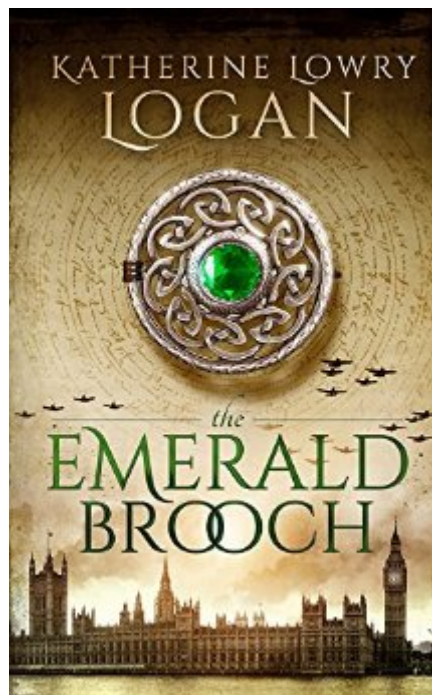

I've been waiting on this one a while now, after I read the first two books in the series in the span of one week. Once again Katherine not only has a wonderful story woven with new and familiar characters, but it is engaging as well. Absolutely one of my favorite series, hands down. I look forward to every book, and as a series the stories are distinct enough to not be stale by book three. While the same concept keeps bringing them back and forth in time, it's always a new story. She's doing it very very right, and I appreciate it!

This is book four. I've not read books one thru three or any other books by this author before now BUT I'll be purchasing them tonight. I bought this book due to a Facebook suggestion because it contained time travel & Scotland. My two favorite story lines that can so easily be a let down. But this book? What I got was a fabulously well written, chocked full of delicious details & historical tidbits, pleasure to read. Yes, it is that good. Yes, you will enjoy it & Yes, you will need, not want to read more by Katherine Lowry Logan. You can thank me later.

I enjoyed the Ruby Brooch & Sapphire Brooch books much more than this one, which felt a little sloppy to me. The plot was entertaining enough, and Logan's imagination with the MacKlenna family tree is admirable - I enjoy how she interweaves her cast of characters. But her writing style was slightly irritating: every analogy was so extreme (which made them less effective and believable as the story wound on); there were grammatical errors; and characters' physical descriptions changed from page to page. (Example: Zoey's eye color was steel-blue, then suddenly mink-brown. Minor issues, but the author's lack of attention to detail annoyed me.) More than that, I just couldn't get behind the Kenzie character. She's supposed to be this hysterical comedian, but I didn't find her jokes funny, even though everyone she meets on the page thinks she's the funniest person they've ever met. I love jokes, but hers were all groaners. Another reviewer said that she felt Logan did a rush job to meet a deadline. Unfortunately, I had the same impression, even though I'm a fan of her earlier books. I'll still give the Broken Brooch & Diamond Brooch a chance, but I was disappointed in

this rendition.

The latest installment of the The Celtic Brooch Series does not disappoint. David McBain is a no-nonsense Scotsman who is more than a right-hand man to his employer Elliott Fraser. David is the go-to-guy when something needs to be done. There is very little, if anything that he can't accomplish. And this extends to going back in time via one of the previously found brooches to retrieve folks who may have trouble not changing history. When the call comes from a colleague that his sister is missing David is pressed into finding the young woman. But he soon discovers that another brooch has appeared and whisked Kenzie Wallis-Manning back in time to World War II London, just prior to D-Day. As readers are reminded, the brooches have historically transported the receiver back to a time period wherein she meets her soul-mate. It is then the united couple's choice to remain back in time or come forward to today's world. This time David knows he must go back to 1944 to retrieve Kenzie and whoever her mate is. But what will David do when he discovers just who Kenzie's mate is? Full of action, adventure, and romance, the author sweeps the reader back into the midst of London during the nightly bombings and the watchful eyes of Central Intelligence as we follow an undocumented Kenzie into the heart of Bletchley Park. Rich details give evidence of in-depth research that lend historical credence to the story, the reader will find themselves unable to put down the book. Characters from previous books in the series play supporting roles in The Emerald Brooch and provide continuity and fluidity to the series. I thoroughly enjoy this series and look forward to the next book. A robust five stars for The Emerald Brooch.

An other excellent, non-stop, trip to the past. This author is a talented researcher. Once again the characters were engaging and believable. All loose ends tied up- which I greatly appreciate. You do need to read the books in order to understand the significance of the brooches- otherwise it is a complete story which stands alone.

I actually read this out of order - probably some sale. I really loved this book, the characters, the way it was written. The writing is so detailed that the book was more than usually visual for me. I've read # 1 and am on #2 and hate to stop reading! (but I have stuff to do!). These are real page turners. I recommend to those who like historical fiction and time travel.

I have read every book so far in this series and have enjoyed each and every book. I like the fact that there is a connection with the characters either in the present or past life. This book provided

more information on the brooches and the fact that there will be a few more stories in the future.

Lots of detail and homework make these books by Katherine Lowry Logan work. Her characters are believable and likable. You'll get involved in their stories and be looking for more to come. If you like historical fiction these are great books to read. I'm off to read book 5 in the series. Something tells me it's going to be another good read.
