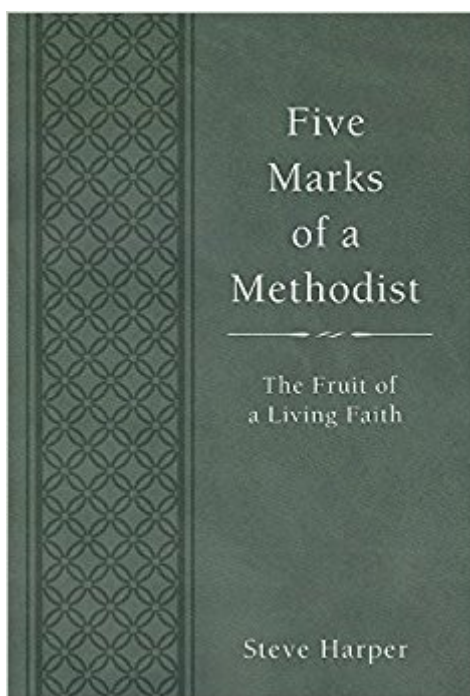


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# Five Marks Of A Methodist: The Fruit Of A Living Faith (Wesley Discipleship Path Series)
