This is basically a coffee table book about the JAZZ AGE. The B&W photos are very large, since the book itself is large in size. I do wish the author had expanded on each chapter, because I feel the author missed a few special Jazz Age experiences, here and there. Though the book is large in size, it is NOT thick in size---thus, there are not as many photos as a reader might expect.

This Time-Life series contains page after page of photos from the decade each book covers. Very little text, but the pictures portray the history, the emotion, and the subtext of the moment. Prominent leaders and key moments of our growth as a nation sit side by side with regular American citizens and everyday life. Invaluable.
