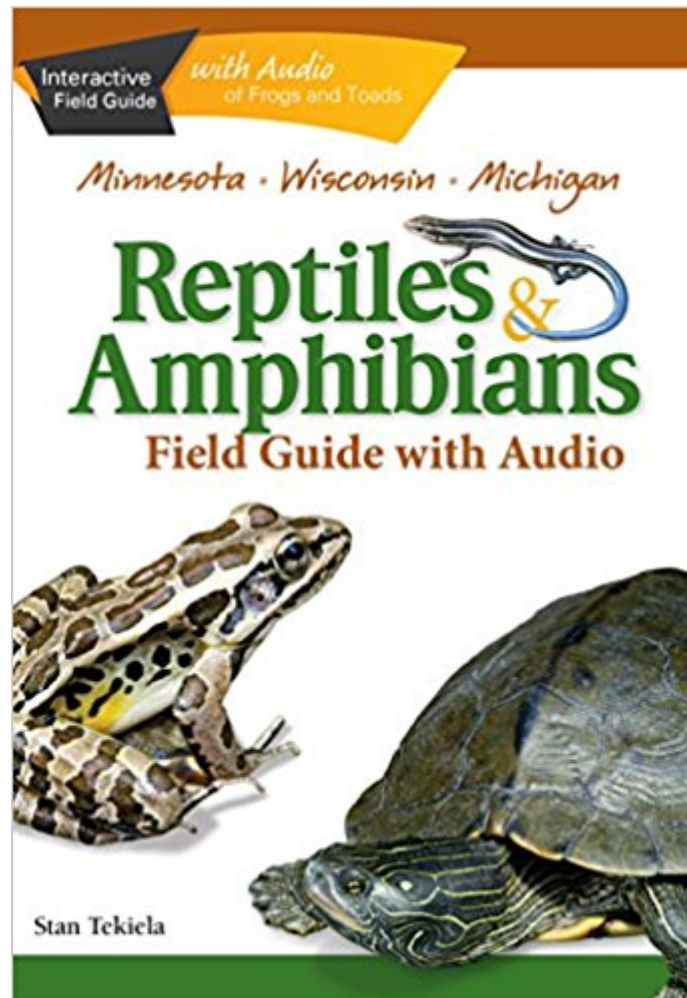

On the pages identifying a species, there is a nice color photo on one side and the animal's detailed information on the other side.
