After Ginny Blackstone receives notification that her favorite aunt, Peg, has died at thirty-five of brain cancer, she receives a package of thirteen letters from her aunt sending her traveling alone across Europe and each envelope includes a task for her to perform. Ginny is a somewhat timid girl and finds some of the tasks quite challenging. The letters are Peg's way of imparting some wisdom to Ginny since she won't be there for her as she had promised. I enjoyed the book. I did think that it required some suspension of belief.

While this is classified as a young adult novel, it translates well to adults also. A shy young girl, grieving for her recently deceased aunt, finds herself on an epic quest across Europe while following the instructions left for her in 13 envelopes. Charming, addictive and worthwhile!

Enjoyed this read, although perhaps I would've liked the aunt's letters to be longer and more in-depth. Overall, however, it was a charming, fun read that I plowed through fairly quickly, and I will probably pick up its sequel, *The Last Little Blue Envelope*, to find out what the final blue envelope says!

Ginny travels all over Europe following her Aunts directions. She discovers courage that she never realised she had. Makes new friends and potential boyfriends. For a 17 year old, this is the biggest adventure of her life. This was an amazing adventure that does contain a sad story as well. I was crying along with Ginny and laughing. Overall this was a great book and even better knowing there is a sequel.

After the early death of her Aunt Peg, Ginny embarks on a trans-Atlantic romp that brings her from London to Greece, Rome, Copenhagen by way of instructions in thirteen envelopes written by Peg to recreate her own travels through Europe. Worried that her beloved niece has been too quiet and shy for far too long, Peg develops the envelope adventure as a way to bring Ginny to a totally new place -- and give her the ride of her life -- after she is no longer there to guide her into adulthood. It

was a bit unrealistic! Very high-school!

This book was the plane ticket I didn't have to buy! The story takes you all around Europe following Ginny as she follows her dead Aunt Peg's 13 little blue envelopes. On her travels, Ginny meets a boy from a Starbucks play & HE'S HILARIOUS AND CUTE with a british accent. Ginny learns about herself and her Aunt Peg...as well as some others. I love Maureen Johnson's writing, I've never had a problem with it. She's a great writer and I have nothing negative about this! JUST READ IT.

Having a dead aunt can't be fun, but how about when she sends you 13 blue envelopes that send you to about 6 countries and a butt load of money? Virginia gets letters from her dead aunt, and she follows what she wrote her, taking Virginia to crazy adventure of making friends, learning something, and taking big steps that she could never see herself do.

I was beginning to feel a little left out in the YA world. Why? Because I had not read a book by Maureen Johnson. I knew I had to fix this and fix it quickly!
