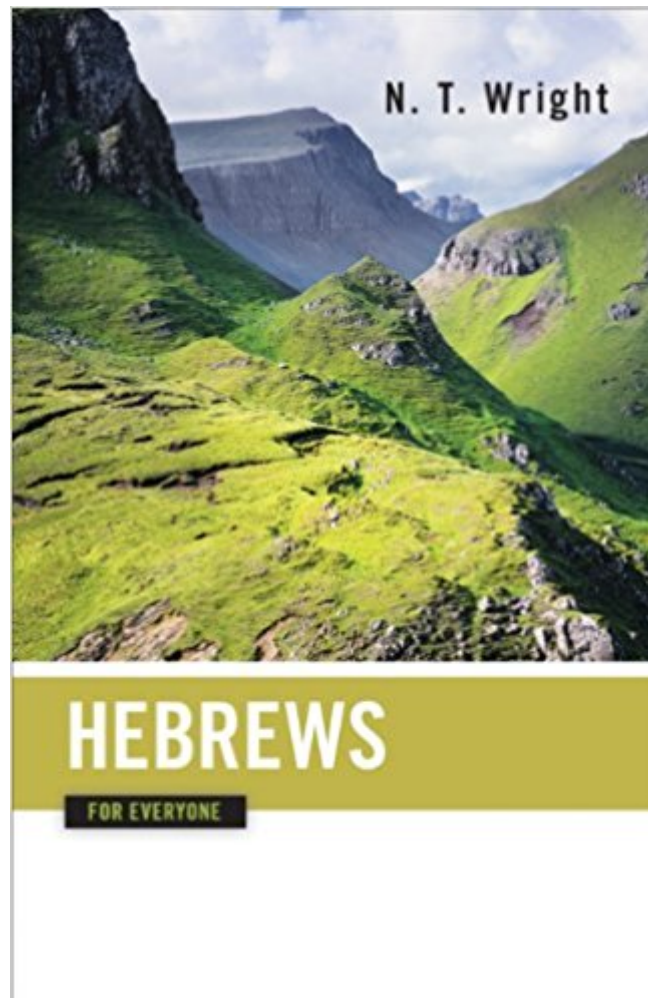

Yet, like meeting a new friend, Wright helps us to find Hebrews full of interest and delight, with a powerful message that comes home to the church of today and tomorrow just as much as it did to the church of yesterday. Tom Wright has undertaken a tremendous task: to provide guides to all the books of the New Testament, and to include in them his own translation of the entire text. Each short passage is followed by a highly readable discussion with background information, useful explanations and suggestions, and thoughts as to how the text can be relevant to our lives today. A glossary is included at the back of the book. The series is suitable for group study, personal study, or daily devotions.

Years of study shine through as NTW brings forth truth in clarity, showing the simplicity is indeed a step above complexity. This would make a great devotional read over 41 days and give the reader a increased depth of understanding; A great love for what has been accomplished by Jesus; A real appreciation of the major themes of the New Testament being expressed in this great book. NTW writes personally and in an easy-to-read style.

I have not found anything N.T. Wright has written that I don't love. Deep, but not too deep. Great for anyone studying this book and wants it to come alive for them. Theologically, seems really sound as most things he writes.

Different from most commentaries, easier to understand. Excellent for the new Christian while still being a good resource for deeper study. Wright gives examples from daily life to illustrate main points. The fact he's British vs. American shows through in the nuances of his writing but it's not a big deterrent.

Like the others in this series, it breaks each chapter into reasonably short (but not too short)

passages; each commentary is interesting, clear, devotional, informative; and just detailed enough to be helpful. I usually find the commentary to be fresh and aware of the OT context of the NT books, as well as of issues of social justice. (I have just read his commentary on James.)
