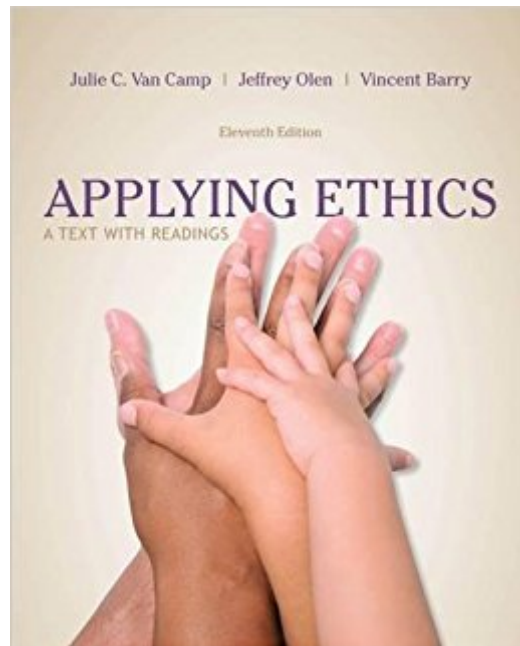

"Applying Ethics: A Text with Readings" is an excellent anthology for introductory college level applied ethics courses. I've taught applied ethics at the college level for nearly 20 years and am familiar with quite a few different applied ethics texts. This is one of the best. Each issue covered

begins with a summary of the issue itself, followed by a brief description of the major arguments on both (or all) sides of the particular issue written by the book's editors. Following this there are four articles (most of them written by philosophers) on each topic. The editors have done a pretty good job in achieving a balance with each of the topics. The discussion of each issue closes with several "case presentations."

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
