

Length: 91 pages. This was an okay book for the price. I was expecting a little bit more of a travelogue or a memoir type of book. Instead, I got a book that, in a roundabout way, addressed many concerns that my wife and I have about traveling with our Yorkie and three cats. In other words, I actually got a book that spoke to our concerns better than I'd have hoped. Yet, in many ways, it only skimmed the surface. Mind you, it didn't strike out with me. The writer does stimulate ideas and some solutions and does a good job at such in an engaging conversational tone. I am rating this as a four star, mostly because the writing style is so engaging. Some photographs and a bit more in the way of providing solutions and case studies would make this a 5 Star book. That, and reducing the price to about \$3.50, as \$4.99 seems a bit high.

While I have been camping for years with both cats and dogs I obtained some helpful tips I had not thought of. My dog d love to camp. In the past my trips have been only a few days at a time next winter I plan to spend a longer time on the road. This book was worth the investment.

I apologize, but I personally found this e-book short on the practical side of things. The author is very chatty and engaging, but substantive content is lacking. While I realize that every pet situation may be unique, there were no helpful tips about food storage, or bedding, or cleanliness (flea and tick protection?), or on-the-road resources ... you know, things that might be useful in a mobile situation. What about the first aid kit? No list in the Kindle version I read. Her advice? Get your vet to give you a list. Yes, of course this is common sense, but the lady is writing a book and charging money for it and so I just expected a little more.

We are thinking of getting a trailer and traveling with our cats. The book read easily and had useful information, so I was pleased. It was well organized with a good table of contents, so I could skip dog-specific chapters. There were hyper links (i.e. to a type of cat carrier available at) that did not work when I used the Kindle app on my iPad. However, I tried the book on the Kindle for Mac application on my computer, and the hyper links did work then. I point that out for others.
