

This book was useful during a four-day trip to Cyprus. The wine tour of western Cyprus was particularly fun and the restaurant recommendations were helpful for Paphos and Nicosia. Additionally, the maps of the highways and Paphos region were accurate. The only complete was the map of Nicosia. The street layout approaching the old city was difficult to comprehend, especially while driving and attempting to navigate.

Useful information, as usual for Lonely Planets. However, I do wish the publishers would design their books so that they are more user-friendly: the print is too small and it's much too close to the spine, making it difficult for one to use a magnifying glass. Correcting these things would make for a bigger book, of course, but readers would appreciate it.

Very handy guide. Spent a limited amount of time on this very hot island (August) and the insightful tips helped me avoid the pitfalls of exploring a new place.
