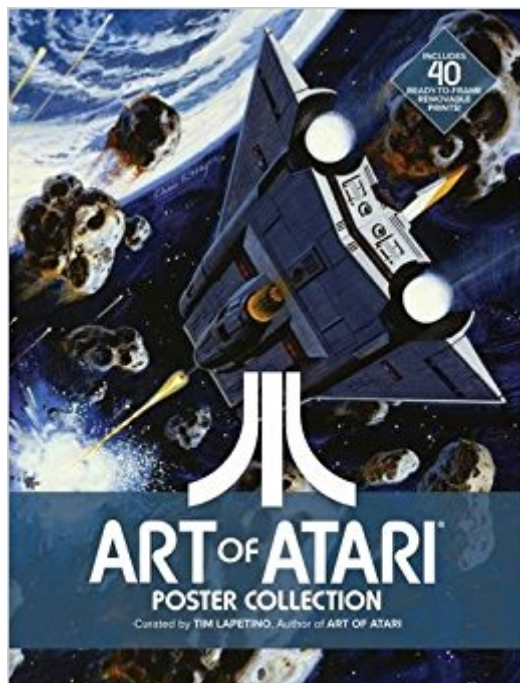

The Atari we may remember may be long gone but their memories will always be in our hearts, and on our walls. These art portrait representations never looked better over 40 years, they're high quality prints with a good weight and thickness to them. This is my nostalgia and a great way for us to look back at the beginning of true video game art.

Unbeatable price for the quality of prints, and a decent selection of games that should have something for everyone. As other reviewers have noted, the 40 posters are on 20 pieces of paper...so if you're looking to frame them you need to buy two copies of the collection. Some of my personal favorites of the covers represented here include the two Missile Commands, Surround, Super Breakout, and Warlords. Would have been nice if this included games like Codebreaker, Air Sea Battle, or any of the Activision games (such as Pitfall!)... and fewer generic sports titles. I'm sure there are licensing issues with some of the games that are missing, but maybe we'll see more in a volume 2??

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
