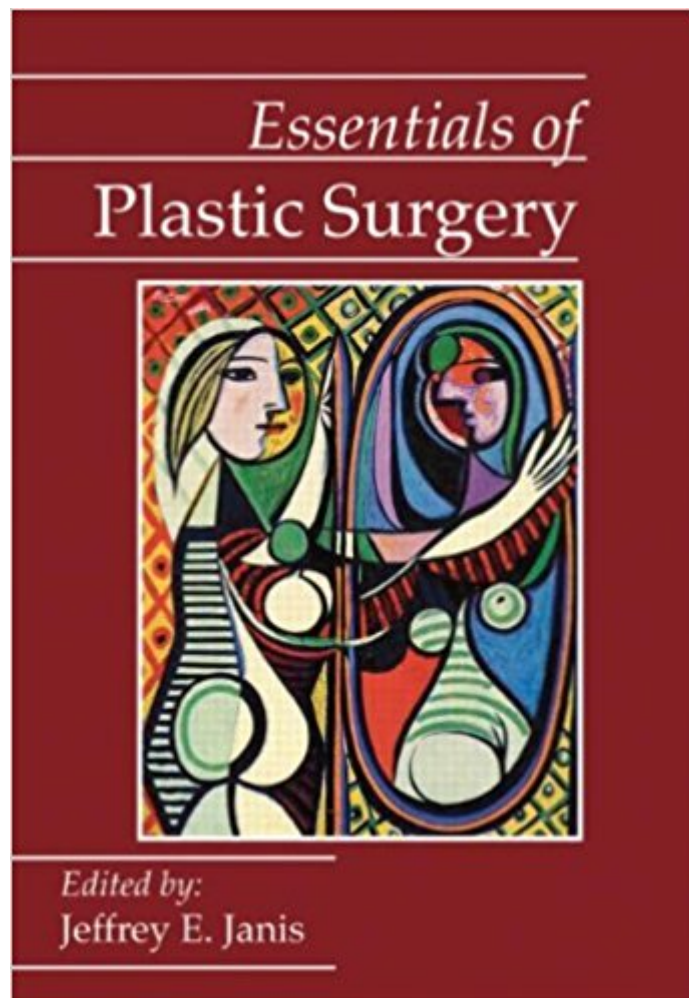

Composed of 88 chapters, the book is divided into 7 separate sections: Fundamentals and Basics Skin and Soft Tissue Head and Neck Breast Trunk and Lower Extremity Hand, Wrist, and Upper Extremity Aesthetic Surgery Unlike many handbooks, this book does not skimp on aesthetic surgery information; face lift, neck lift, fillers, and breast augmentation are given equal time with reconstructive topics such as wound healing, flaps, and microsurgery. A detailed bibliography is included at the end of each chapter to direct the reader to additional resource material.

Design Enhances Readability and Practicality This handbook's design and organization allow quick and easy reading. The outline format permits optimal coverage of information and facilitates retention and understanding. Bulleted lists, tables, boxes, and numerous illustrations help to illuminate key points and important information. In addition, the two-color design increases the text's readability and makes it easier to locate information. No other plastic surgery handbook provides as much information in such a compact format.
