

(Okay, so I've been following this series for almost five years and I am so pumped.) Honestly, the final volume came at a good time - the series was beginning to feel drawn out, and it became very difficult to follow all the characters. But I like how everything is wrapped up very nicely and has come a long way from the first volume. There is a myriad of twists and turns throughout the adventures of Oz, Alice and Gil, and I have to say that the last volume is no different. There is a resolution regarding Alice and the Intention of the Abyss, and the motives for Jack's past mania are explained. We learn about the fates of these characters, and although I wish I could have seen more character development - more layers for the Alice we've come to love in particular - the ending somehow feels right. I won't give anything away for fear of spoilers, but there are two main elements to the last chapters of this story: 1) Battle/confrontation with the chains, as well as the Intention of the Abyss 2) The equivalent of an epilogue with insight as to how the Abyss has changed itself and the lives of these characters (whilst preserving some of the mystery) While there are a few loose ends, I personally loved it. A very tasteful end to my favorite manga series of all time.
