

As a nurse, most of the book's contents consisted of scenarios I'd experienced many times, albeit

arranged in an amusing and cheerful manner. A person with no medical working experience would probably enjoy the (mostly true) look at the behind-the-scenes goings on. I would recommend it for such a person.
