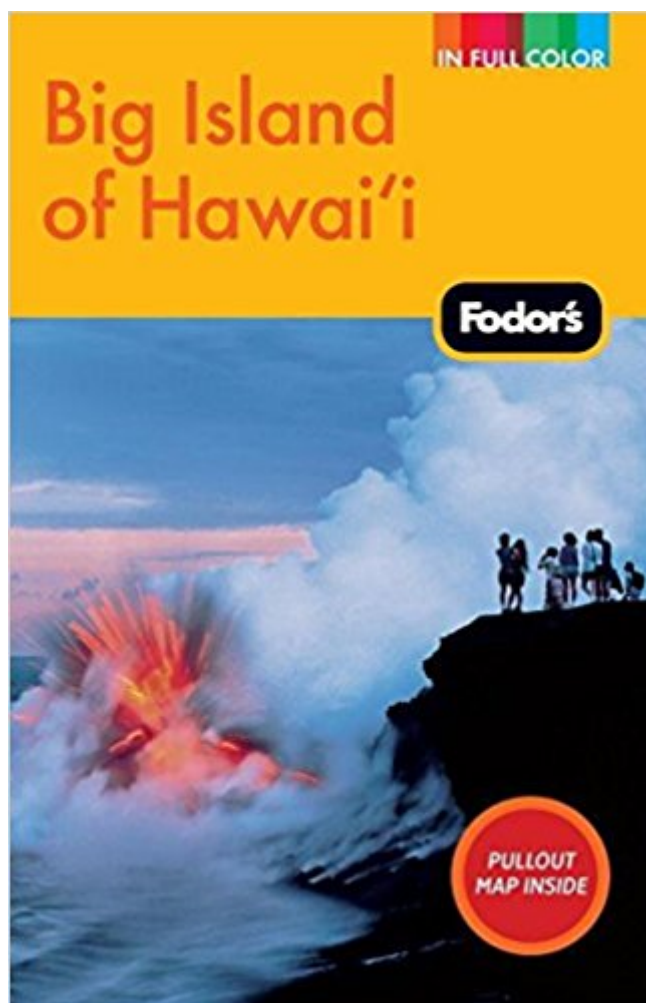

We took our first trip to the Hawaiian Islands last year, and I wanted to know all about the Big Island before we got there. I'm so glad I did! They really aren't kidding when they call it "The Big Island." It is much too big to see everything on the island in one week, so reading up beforehand allowed me and my husband to narrow down our options and make the most of our time. I had never read a Fodor's book before any of our travels, so I really wanted to put it to the test. All the historical, cultural and environmental information was extremely interesting and helpful. But I wasn't sure how much we would agree with all the Fodor's recommendations. By the end of the week, I found that I agreed almost completely with all the reviews and recommendations in the book. I took this book with me every time we left the resort, and my husband and I found some of the best places because of it. We probably would never have bothered to stop at the tropical botanical gardens-- one of our favorite outings from the trip-- if this Fodor's book hadn't recommended it. Another day we had the most amazingly delicious breakfast at a little restaurant that we would have absolutely NEVER found without Fodor's. I think we used everything from the pronunciation guide to the map! The 15 or so dollars we spent on purchasing this book was worth its weight in gold.

We used this book on a recent trip to Hawaii. It helped us find the mainstream attractions... like Volcano National Park and some beautiful beaches. It also helped us find fun places to eat like Verna's in Hilo (packed with locals because the food was so good and the prices so reasonable) and Huli Sue's in Waimea (a fun place to stop for lunch). When used with the GPS, this book was a great "tour guide." There were a couple of places mentioned in the book that were no longer open, but in general the information was right on.

Though used... it showed no evidence of ever being really opened. Saw from the spine it was fr. a library (dewey decimal system). May everyone be so lucky to get such a good-shaped edition. Am

really happy with the info on the beaches, Kona proper and the location on map of places I need to visit. So it is a couple yrs old.. that's OK -the price was RIGHT.
