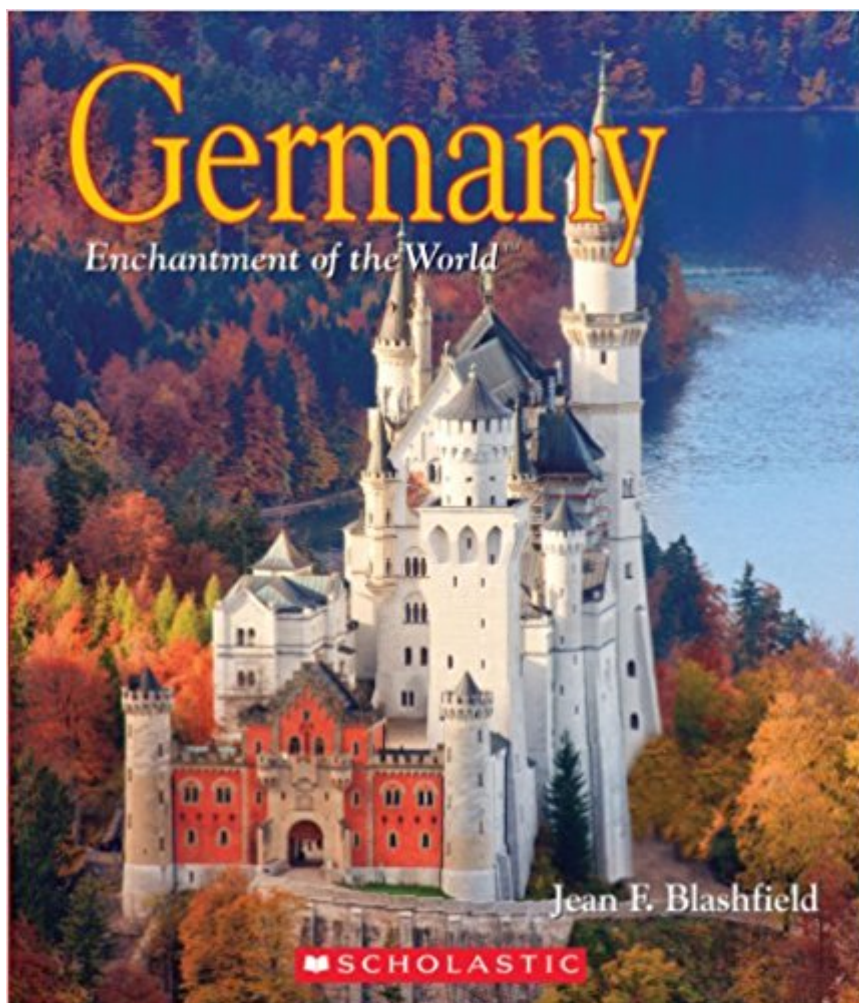

This is Jean F. Blashfield's 2nd updated edition of (EOW) series. This new 2013 edition is a much

better update than the one Ms. Blasfield wrote ten years earlier. She gets to the heart of German culture in this brand new edition. She mentions famous Germans like Martin Luther, Johannes Gutenberg, Dietrich Bohnhoeffer, the Brothers Grimm, beautiful Neuschwanstein castle (The cover of the book!), Johann Wolfgang von Goethe, Ludwig van Beethoven, Albert Einstein, and Germany's first female Federal Chancellor, Angela Merkel. The book is filled with full color photographs, Germany's history, language, culture and customs, and of course, German cuisine! Although Ms. Blasfield mentions typical German foods like German Bratwurst and cabbage, she should have also mentioned at least one German recipe like other (EOW) authors do in their books on countries. She should have added a recipe on German potato salad at least. Overall, the book is excellent and it is a must read for anyone interested in German culture! Mach Spass!

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
