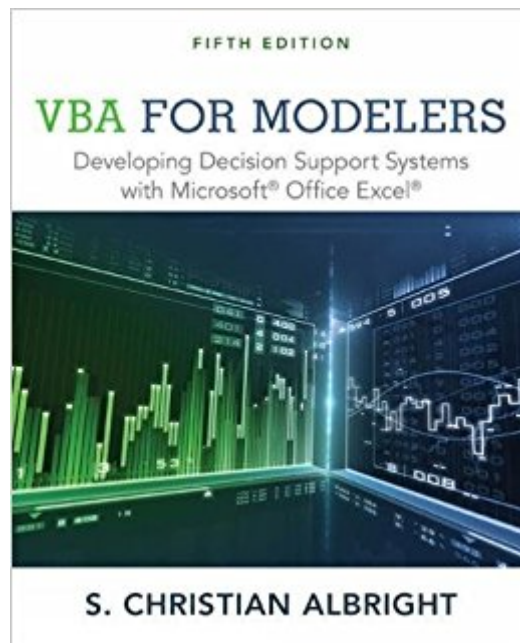

Since then, he has been teaching in the Operations and Decision Technologies Department in the Kelley School of Business at Indiana University until his retirement in 2011. He has taught courses in management science, computer simulation, and statistics to all levels of business students: undergraduates, MBAs, and doctoral students. His current interest is in spreadsheet modeling, including development of VBA applications in Excel. Dr. Albright has published more than 20 articles in leading operations research journals in applied

probability. He has also published several successful textbooks, including BUSINESS ANALYTICS: DATA ANALYSIS AND DECISION MAKING; DATA ANALYSIS FOR MANAGERS; SPREADSHEET MODELING AND APPLICATIONS; and VBA FOR MODELERS.

I've used this book to teach second year finance students as well as students taking finance AND computer science since the second edition and I find it to be an excellent book. Very accessible for beginning programmers as the author does not make assumptions about what the student knows already. Great textbook because of the examples and exercises, which are very hard to find in other reference books on VBA. The second half of the book contains great code examples from the real world, and even students not in finance will find value in them. All around a great book I've been using for years.

One of the best VBA training book, even without Part II of the book dealing with Science applications and operations research. Regarding the book's companion files, it seems that Cengage Learning have improved with this matter and the companion files are published in a public companion site, just google: vba for modelers companion site and choose: Book Companion Site (choose the first one, the other are for previous editions). Actually I bought this pricey book just after verifying that the files are publically available since quite a few reviews complained about the missing/hard to get companion files and even some reviewed the book just with 1 star because of that.

Accompanying files are hard to get. But even you get them, the file set is not full, and lion portion of "exercise" files are not included, making the most exercises which required accompanying files useless. Hope the publisher could fix this issue one day, making this book more valuable. Also please note that exercises are coming without solutions, so this book is not perfect for self-study in my opinion.

I started with no knowledge of VB and this book brought me to the point where I'm turning week-long exercises into a couple days. I used it without all of the accompanying materials and still found it to be very useful. Highly recommend.
