

These are not the world's best-written books, but they entertain. The writing is very uneven: pretty

good in some places, cringingly vague and awful in others. Overall, it's about an 8th-grade reading level. They should have marketed these as children's fiction, it definitely isn't "adult"-level material. Nevertheless, for idle reading, it's alright. And it's only \$2.99 per installment.

I found this book way too short to be the first in a series, and yet it felt too long in the sense that I couldn't wait to finish it so I could go read something else. I didn't feel invested at all in whatever happened to the main character. There were definitely a few passages that needed better editing. In short, unless you find it for free (maybe even so), give it a pass.

This is the first very short book in a new fantasy series about a planet where the people have been divided into "chromes", tribes of people who identify with a particular clothing color. Not surprisingly, it is about prejudice and authoritative rule. Nothing new, but pretty well done. I purchased the next book in the series.

I started reading this book because it felt like new breath to fantasy reading. The idea and creation of the world is really good. But the way writer fails to present storyline properly. It contains logical holes. Characters, places and are not well described. Keeps the reader wondering whether the details will come next.. I read the whole series because of the storyline.

Enjoyable, and somewhat unpredictable story line that kept my interest the entire time. Great opening book, I look forward to reading the next in line.
