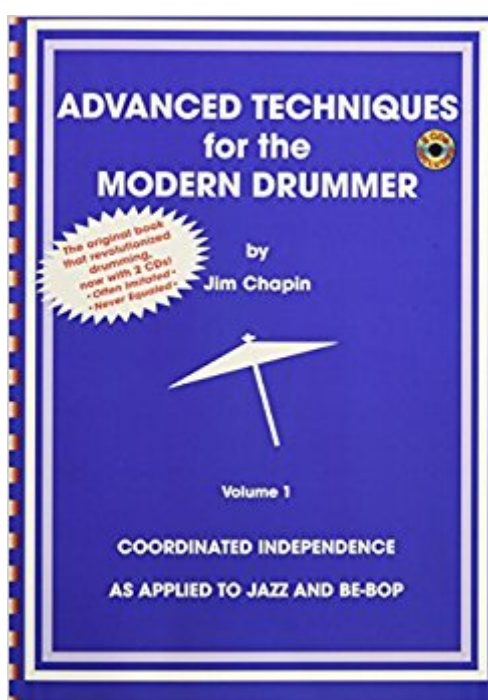

This is THE go-to book for getting basic to advanced jazz limb independence going for the jazz drummer. Recommended by my drum teacher, I've been studying this book for over a year now, and it still reveals new and useful things to me. This advanced my drumming by leaps and bounds. I do recommend working with an instructor while using the book, though.

The Advanced Techniques for the Modern Drummer has been the benchmark in jazz coordination since its release, in 1948. Since then all the serious drummers, study it in a way to better dominate the required technique to play Bop Drumming. Even the creators of Bebop, as confessed Max Roach in an interview, used it to sharpen their comping skills.
