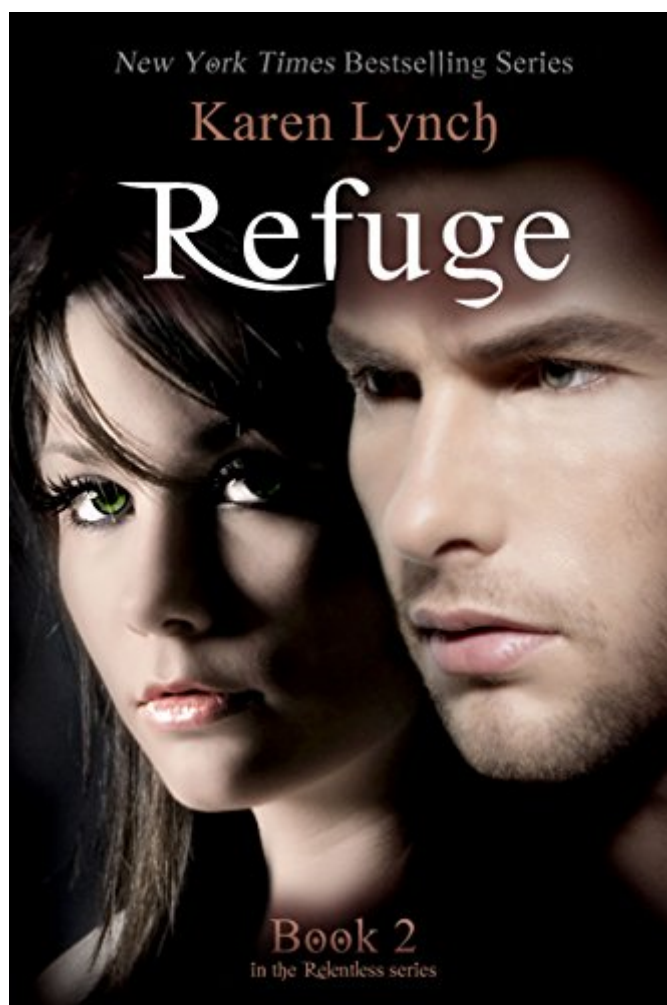


The book was found

So we pick up only about a week after the last book and Sara is in a Mohiri stronghold trying to adjust to her new life. Sara is one of my favorite characters because even though she is young she has been through some pretty-horrible things and survived, she is older than her years and cares for people and creatures unconditionally. She is strong, takes her life into her own hands, is fiercely loyal to the people she cares about and will not turn away from challenging things. In Refuge Sara has a lot to deal with including the fact that her powers are growing and her growing feelings for a certain Mohiri (talking about you Nikolas). I love Nikolas and he is just as stormy and completely sexy as he ever was. Now he and Sara are getting closer and I love seeing the dynamic that goes on between the two while they are trying to figure everything out. New people, New people. We get introduced to several new characters including Sara's Mohiri family. That's right we meet them and I totally guessed it. I love the relationship that Sara forms with them and I love seeing them interact with each other, especially since Sara has been pretty guarded her whole life and didn't use to show her emotions to well. It's not often that I would take the time out to write a review despite the fact I rely quite heavily on the recommendations of others when I'm choosing potential reading material. I found Relentless when browsing my recommendations and was so totally enamoured of the story that followed that I immediately went and posted a review....my first one ever. I obsessively tracked the progress of Refuge and was happily given the chance to get my hands on an ARC without having to donate organs or sell my soul. Once again Karen Lynch has me struck dumb with her imagination and creativity. The story continues the development of Nicholas and Sara's relationship and flows in such a realistic way that it generates a range of differing emotions throughout the book. We learn

more about the Mohiri, are introduced to several new characters and see a few old ones pop in as well. Karen seamlessly integrates old and new characters and develops these relationships with ease. Each character has their place and purpose and Karen brings them all together in a story that will have you enthralled until the very end. Books containing Vampires and Werewolves are so commonplace nowadays that it can often be easy to assume one is much like the other...definitely not true in this case! Karen's concept is new and unlike any other that you will have come across that you will be absolutely thrilled with the new direction she is heading in. Buy a copy today, you won't regret it. If Sara thought leaving Maine to move to the Idaho Mohiri compound was going to keep her family and friends safe and dissuade more excitement ('disaster,' as Nikolas would say) in her life, she was blissfully naive about her "Refuge." The beginning of the story settles us nicely into Mohiri life and we learn, as Sara does, a lot about her heritage on both sides of her family, smoothly transitioning from the cliffhanger of book 1 that left so many questions. But with every answer, new questions and situations arise with new friends, new family, new creatures, new powers, and new emotions and responsibilities for Sara. I'm pretty sure I looked like a hale witch had control of my mind while reading as I laughed, cried, swooned, sighed, panicked, yelled, and gloated all within the 1 day that I sped through the book, glued to Karen Lynch's gripping writing (both times I read it). Sara definitely has to grow up quite a bit in this story and learn how to better fend for herself (because, let's face it, she was you-go-girl independent, but a poor fighter in *Relentless*) while concurrently growing to accept the help and support of others. I actually marked quite a few beautifully phrased lines as life lessons I should heed myself. *Refuge* is a great sequel, almost better than the first, once again full of creative supernatural ideas, strong emotions, fascinating characters, and nail-biting action. Cannot wait for the 3rd and final book, *Rogue*! This is definitely one of my all-time favorite book series!
