

I purchased this book as a gift for someone traveling in Europe and they told me that they got so many great recommendations as they were traveling around. The small maps, restaurant recommendations, and tips for travelers (places to avoid) were handy and kept them well entertained throughout their trip.

I traveled in Belgium and Luxembourg for two weeks and this book was a great jumping off point when I was unsure what to do in a city. The main cities I traveled to were Brussels, Luxembourg City, Antwerp, Gent, and Bruges. I was traveling by myself so this book helped me find places I would not have seen otherwise. Most of the information in the travel guide can be found online, however it is convenient to have a hard copy to take notes in and to point you to things that you would not have even considered visiting. For example, in Bruges I saw some lithified jesus blood! It was written up in the book and I had no idea it even existed or that it was on display. The prices were not always accurate but hours of operation usually were. I spent some time hiking in eastern Belgium and northern Luxembourg, many of the small towns that I walked through were not mentioned in the guide, while it would be nice to have some beta on them as well, they were far from touristy. The book is great but far from exhaustive, keep your eyes open and listen to the locals. Have a great trip!
